Infant Adoption

Counseling, education and support for birth and adoptive families. Since we've opened our doors in 1918, we've helped thousands of parents grow their families through infant adoption.

303 nurses, social workers and community professionals, participated in adoption focused professional education to enhance care for families walking through adoption.

233 adoptees and family members of adoptees received post-adoption services.



Foster Care Services

Children facing abuse and/or neglect in their birth home are placed in safe, stable temporary care with a foster family. To better serve the children in our care, we increased our licensing level of care from "Basic/Moderate" to "Specialized" and developed a TEA-approved trauma-sensitivity training course to help teachers understand how trauma affects foster children in the classroom.



7.000 + nights of care for 34 foster children.

Youth Education and Prevention

A preventative education program designed to equip youth, ages 13–19, with the knowledge to make healthy, informed decisions about their future.

4,682 youth in 11 school districts throughout Dallas and Tarrant County participated in the Love Notes and ABCs of Adoption curriculum.

The Love Notes program received the GD-SRAE award through the Family and Youth Service's Bureau (FYSB) Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Program, which will serve 9,000 teenagers over the next three years.



Parenting Support

Provided one-on-one case management, peer support, groups and parenting classes for 536 parents to overcome obstacles and provide a safe, loving home for their children.

We were founded in 1918 as an orphanage for babies abandoned on the streets due to the Spanish Flu and post-WWI fatalities at a time when the state had no organized way of caring for these children. 




